Hedgehogs live in many countries of the world. In England, there is only one type of hedgehog. It has brown fur on its stomach. In Iraq, for example, there are different types of hedgehog. One type has white <u>fur</u> on its <u>stomach</u>. The second type has long ears. All types of hedgehogs have long <u>spines</u>.
